



## Community Partnerships Against Domestic and Family Violence

Domestic violence is a crime and an abuse of human rights. It is not a normal part of a relationship. It includes threats, harassment, fear, intimidation or abusive behaviour used by one person to control another.

- Physical
- Emotional
- Verbal
- Sexual
- Social (isolation from family and friends)
- Economic (controlling money)
- Spiritual or cultural

These are all forms of domestic violence and they usually get worse over time.

Our service provides a broad range of assistance including case management, programs, support talking to the Police, and referral to other services.

Our service has support rooms in Kempsey, Port Macquarie, Taree and Police Stations and is co-ordinated from Liberty Cottage in Port Macquarie.
